





#### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING

The Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development and Use Classes) (Scotland) Miscellaneous Amendment Order 2023

Made	8th February 2023
Laid before the Scottish	
Parliament	10th February 2023
Coming into force	31st March 2023

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 26(2)(f), 30, 31 and 275 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997(1) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

Part 1

General

#### Citation and commencement

 This Order may be cited as the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development and Use Classes) (Scotland) Miscellaneous Amendment Order 2023 and comes into force on 31 March 2023.

#### Application

2.—(1) The amendments made by this Order do not apply to development begun before 31 March 2023.

(2) For the purposes of paragraph (1) development is to be taken to be begun on the earliest date on which any material operation (within the meaning of section 27(4) of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997) comprised in the development begins to be carried out.
